The X, Y and Z of Interpreting Math

This workshop was designed to assist mathematics teachers, sign language interpreters and interpreting students to become familiar with mathematical signs. We will discuss the rationale behind choosing certain signs and provide opportunities for interpreters to practice incorporating them in their interpretations.
